

LYDNEY GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. PLANTATIONS – PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES

All plantations are fully in play. If, within a plantation, a tree is staked and interferes with a player's stance or swing the ball must be lifted and dropped, no nearer the hole, in accordance with Rule 16.1f (Immovable Obstruction). Full relief of stance and swing must be determined and the ball dropped within one club-length of this point of full relief, no nearer the hole than where it originally lay. The nearest point of relief may be outside the outer trees of the plantation. The ball may be cleaned before it is dropped.

2. INTERNAL OUT OF BOUNDS

Hole 2/11 A ball coming to rest when it is to the Left of the white posts from the end of the plantation up to the ditch below the 13 tee box. Holes 1/10 and 6/15 – A ball is out of bounds when it is at rest to the left of the white stakes starting from the 1/10 tee box and running all the way to the 1/10 green.

Hole 8/17 – A ball is out of bounds when it is at rest to the left of the white stakes along the hedge between 8/17 and hole 7/16, starting at the ditch across hole 7/16 and continuing to the rear of the 6th green. These stakes do not apply to hole 6/15 or 7/16 and relief may be taken without penalty if these stakes obstruct a player's stance or swing while playing these holes.

Hole 5/14 and 9/18 – A ball is out of bounds if it comes to rest behind the white chains bordering the lawn/putting area behind the 9/18 green.

3. OVERHEAD CABLES

If a ball strikes any overhead cable the shot must be cancelled and the stroke must be replayed.

4. MARKER POLES/STAKES

Red and yellow stakes and distance and marker poles are obstructions and relief may be taken without penalty or the stake temporarily

removed without penalty. White stakes indicating out of bounds or course boundaries are integral parts of the course when playing the hole the stakes relate to.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Includes any artificial structure such as distance markers, bridges, made up paths, telegraph poles and out of bounds markers, not relating to the hole in play. Relief is available without penalty if an immovable obstruction interferes with a player's stance or swing, unless the ball has come to rest within a penalty area, in which case the player is not entitled to relief without penalty. All bridges are within the penalty areas.

6. EMBEDDED BALL

Balls embedded in its OWN pitchmark, anywhere on the course (except in a penalty area) may be lifted, cleaned and DROPPED as near as possible to the place where the ball originally lay without penalty. Further, if winter rules are in force then a ball may be marked, lifted, cleaned and placed within 6" of where it lay no nearer the hole anywhere on the course (except in a penalty area). Divots should always be replaced after the shot has been taken.

7. BUNDS & GROUND UNDER REPAIR

All areas marked with blue markers are GUR from which play and stance and presence is PROHIBITED. If a ball is not found in GUR then a ball may be dropped within one club-length of the last point of entry, no nearer the hole, without penalty. If a ball is found in GUR then a ball may be dropped within one club-length from the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, without penalty. The Club will not accept any responsibility for the Health and Safety of players who enter the BUND/GUR areas whatsoever.
